Objectives	<p>Candidates should achieve the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide an understanding of the hazards associated with operating a quad bike on various terrain and the measures which must be put in place to reduce the risks. • To provide a knowledge of the personal protective equipment which must be worn when operating a quad bike. • To identify quad bike controls and their functions. • To demonstrate an ability to carry out the necessary daily maintenance checks required on a quad bike. • To provide an understanding of quad bike loading requirements and load limits. • To demonstrate an ability to safely and effectively operate a quad bike on various terrain both as a standalone unit and also with various items of equipment attached. • To appreciate the need to carry out a post-use check.
