Duration:	2 days training, including integrated City & Guilds NPTC MEWP assessment. 1 day City & Guilds NPTC Assessment for Chainsaw from a MEWP (completed approx. one week after the course to encourage consolidation and practice)

Venue:	This is normally completed on a mwmac Ltd site near Builth Wells, Powys. If you have enough people for a full course we are able, in some instances, to run this course on your site (subject to a pre-course visit).

Objectives	<ul> <li>Candidates should achieve the following:</li> <li>To be able to review of current legislation and risk assessment</li> <li>To undertake MEWP inspection and setup</li> <li>To explain and undertake Emergency Procedures</li> <li>To be able to operate MEWP according to industry best practice</li> <li>Be able to prepare a mobile elevated work platform for operation</li> <li>Be able to operate a mobile elevated work platform</li> <li>Be able to prepare the mobile elevated work platform for transport</li> <li>To carry out Chainsaw inspection and pre/post safety/operational checks</li> <li>To undertake free fall and hand held cuts to required specification</li> <li>To demonstrate effective use of pull ropes</li> <li>To carry out post use inspection of MEWP</li> <li>To leave site in a tidy manner</li> <li>To be able to work safely.</li> </ul>

A diameter of 10mm is recommended by HSE</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Strop/Lanyard - min. diameter 10mm – max diameter 14mm is recommended by HSE. Min. length 5m</li> <li>Karabiners, triple lock x 3</li> <li>Chainsaw Tool Strop – NB Chainsaw tool strops are part of LOLER 6 month inspection</li> <li>Chainsaw</li> <li>Fuel, oil and maintenance kit for saw</li> </ul>

Equipment Continued:	<ul> <li>Combination Helmet with ear muffs, visor and chin strap. HSE strongly recommends mountaineering style helmet complying with BS EN 12492</li> <li>Chainsaw Safety boots, with good grip and ankle support complying with BS EN ISO 20345.</li> <li>Chainsaw Trousers – Class A or C</li> <li>Knife with either a lockable folding blade or a fixed blade held in a protective sheath.</li> <li>Gloves (complying with EN381-7 if Chainsaw Gloves)</li> <li>Personal First Aid Kit for belt or pocket including Large wound dressing</li> <li>Whistle</li> <li>High-Visibility Jacket or Vest</li> </ul>
